

Staff, Faculty Honored For Service To Campus

Nine employees and faculty members at Indiana University East were honored Friday morning for their years of service to the university.

Susan Orr, assistant business manager, has the most seniority at the local campus. She has been with IU East, and its predecessor institutions, for more than 18 years.

Professor Helen Lees is the senior faculty member with more than 15 years.

Both received IU 15 year pins.

Employees honored for five or more

years of service included Val Clark of student services, Sue Hilbert who manages the bookstore, Bette Davenport of university relations and Helen Pardieck of the faculty support center.

Friday's presentations were part of the first Staff Recognition Ceremony held at IU East. IU East was established only nine years ago and those honored for more than 10 years of

service were a part of the Eastern Indiana Center of IU at Earlham College.

The Staff Recognition Ceremony was held in the Student Quiet Lounge with supervisors of the honored employees making the presentations. The 9 a.m. ceremony included a coffee-and-doughnut reception.
