
PREFACE

This is a list of the holdings of Russian and Ukrainian periodicals on microfilm in the Library of Congress. The supplement shows holdings on microfilm of 17 publications in West European languages dealing with Russia or the Soviet Union.

The entry style follows Library of Congress bibliographic practices with a few departures, e.g., changes in title and frequency are supplied only when they relate to the years for which holdings are shown; publishers are given as they appear on the publications themselves; and the catalog card number is supplied wherever possible, in addition to the Library of Congress call number. The symbol DLC instead of a call number indicates that the publication has not been completely processed.

The numbers following the holdings are the shelflist numbers of the Photoduplication Service. A number standing alone indicates that the microfilm is negative; the abbreviation "pos." preceding the shelflist number indicates that the film is positive; and the abbreviation "neg. and pos." indicates that the holdings are on negative and positive film.

The information on holdings was obtained and consolidated from the files of the Photoduplication Service. In some cases, de visu inspection was necessary to verify data.

Microfilms of the issues listed in this index have been produced or acquired by the Library over a period of more than 25 years from a number of different sources; the film of a single title may include a variety of reductions, image positions and filming quality. Therefore, although the films are legible, the quality is not uniform and the collection generally does not meet current standards of archival quality microfilm. The majority of issues were microfilmed on silver emulsion film, but only ozaphane film exists of certain issues. Silver emulsion microfilm will be supplied on all orders for positive copies, but the quality of definition or readability will vary, depending upon the film quality of the original. In most cases, targets are lacking from the original film also, but these will be added wherever possible in editing and consolidating reels prior to filling orders.

Also, since the master negative film is not arranged on reels in logical bibliographical units, when orders are received for positive microfilm of issues of the same title, whenever possible, the negatives will be spliced together in proper arrangement prior to printing, to form consolidated reels. Once consolidated (approximately 100 feet) reels of master negative microfilm are assembled, only orders to print complete rolls of positive microfilm will be accepted and portions of reels will not be supplied.

The Index is being made available only on a limited basis, primarily as a reference tool for relatively unique material to assist scholars rather than as an advertisement for the sale of microfilm. Inquiries or requests for further information about microfilm listed should be addressed to:
