#### FOREWORD BY THE GENERAL EDITOR

### Roger E. Kanet University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign

The articles published in this volume have been selected from among those presented at the Second World Congress for Soviet and East European Studies, held in Garmisch-Partenkirchen, Federal Republic of Germany, September 30-October 4, 1980. The Congress was sponsored by the International Committee for Soviet and East European Studies in conjunction with the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Osteuropakunde and was attended by well over 1,400 scholars from around the world.

Among the approximately five hundred formal papers and additional papers presented at the Congress, more than 150 were submitted for consideration to the editorial committee for the official English-language Congress publications. From among these a substantial number have been accepted for publication in the series of thirteen volumes to be published by Berkeley Slavic Specialties (Berkeley, CA, USA), Pergamon Press (New York, NY, USA), Russica Publishers (New York, NY, USA), and Martinus Nijhoff Publishers (The Hague, The Netherlands). In addition, several other volumes are scheduled for publication in Germany.

As general editor of the series of English-language Garmisch Congress publications, I wish to express my sincere appreciation to all of the individuals and organizations that made the conference and the resulting publications possible. This includes the numerous organizations that provided financial support for the Congress itself, the Executive of the International Committee for Soviet and East European Studies (including the past president, Adam Bromke) and, in particular, the members of the German Planning Committee who organized the Congress (including the chairman and current president of the International Committee, Oskar Anweiler). Finally, I wish to thank the Congress participants who submitted their papers for consideration, the members of the editorial committee that selected the essays to be included in the various volumes, and the editors of those volumes. Their contributions and cooperation have made possible the publication of this volume and the other volumes in the series.
