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ARRANGEMENT OF ENTRIES

Entries in the first section GENERALITIES (Scripts, Transliteration and transcription in general, Bibliographical and library work, Catalog codes and rules, Re-transliteration) are arranged chronologically. All following entries are generally arranged by source language or script, following the scheme used in the <u>Linguistic Bibliography</u> as displayed in its Table of contents for the year 1969. The target languages or scripts are also arranged in the same manner. Where more than one entry is about the same source and target language or script, the entries are arranged first chronologically, then alphabetically by author's name.

The titles of some sources are abbreviated in accordance with ANSI Z 39.5, Standard for the <u>Abbreviation of Titles of Periodicals</u>. Festschriften are indicated by [Festschr...] followed by the name of the person honored. Titles of conference proceedings and collective works are followed by [C]. Full bibliographical data for all sources will be found in the List of Sources on p. xvii.

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
