OUR ORGANIZATION

THOUGH WE ARE NOT A POLITICAL PARTY, WE ARE A GROUP OF 70,000 CITIZENS COMMITTED TO MAKING THIS A BETTER COUNTRY AND A BETTER WORLD TO LIVE IN BY VIRTUE OF OUR SIZE AND OUR AVOWED AIMS WE BEAR A STRONG RESPONSIBILITY TOWARDS OUR INDIVIOUAL MEMBERS. AND WE DO NOT MERELY TALK. WE ALSO ACT. WE CAN MATCH OUR RECORD OF ACTION AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS WITH THAT OF ANY OTH-ER COMPARABLE ORGANIZATION. BUT WE CAN NEVER DO ENOUGH TOWARDS THE REAL-IZATION OF THE JUST AND ABUNDANT WORLD THAT IS OUR ULTIMATE AIM.

WE TAKE THE LEAD IN FIGHTING FOR TOL-ERANCE AND TRUE RACIAL AND RELIGIOUS FREEDOM THROUGHOUT THE WORLD. WE FIGHT FOR AN ECONOMY OF PLENTY, FOR A WORLD OF EQUALITY, FOR WORLD UNITY, AND EVERLASTING PEACE.

BEING STALWART IN THE STRUGGLE FOR POLITICAL AND INDUSTRIAL DEMOCRACY, WE ARE PART AND PARCEL OF THE LABOR MOVEMENT. WE ARE OF LABOR AND LABOR'S IDEALS AND ASPIRATIONS AND AIMS.

WE RESENT INJUSTICE. AS CITIZENS OF THIS COUNTRY WE WANT EVERYBODY TO BE FREE, AND EQUAL, AND SECURE. WE HAVE OUR VOTES, OUR VOICES AND OUR PENS. WE WILL GET TOGETHER IN OUR UNIONS, CUR POLITICAL PARTIES, OUR VETERANS ORGANIZATIONS, OUR FRATERNAL ORDERS -AND WE WILL KEEP VIGIL OVER THE RIGHTS OF ALL MEN OF ALL RACES. ADVOCATE SUCH REFORMS AND ADVANCES AS WILL ASSURE US A HIGHER STANDARD OF LIVING, AND FREEDOM FROM WANT AND FROM FEAR. AND WE DEMAND OF OUR LEG-ISLATORS THAT THEY SHOW THE LEADER-SHIP EXPECTED OF OUR GREAT NATION IN SOLVING THE PROBLEMS OF PEACE, HUMAN RIGHTS, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY THROUGH-OUT THE WORLD.

WE SHOULD LIKE TO SEE ALL OTHER OR-GANIZATIONS OF PROGRESSIVE, SOCIALLY-MINDED CITIZENS GROWING STRONGER AND MORE ARTICULATE. ALL TOGETHER WE CAN, AND WE WILL, BUILD A BETTER AMERICA AND A BETTER WORLD.

\$ 100,000 TO BE RAISED FOR VLADECK HOME


OVER \$82,000 HAS BEEN RAISED IN A DRIVE BY THE ENGLISH-SPEAKING DIVISION OF THE WORKMEN'S CIRCLE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE VLADECK HOME FOR DISPLACED ORPHANS IN FRANCE. THE ULTIMATE GOAL OF THE NATIONAL ORGANIZATION IS \$100,000.

THIS INSPIRATIONAL ENDEAVOR IS WHOLE-HEARTEDLY SUPPORTED BY THE LOS ANGELES ENGLISH-SPEAKING DIVISION, WHICH HAS PLEDGED ITSELF TO RAISE \$6,000 TOWARDS THE NATIONAL GOAL. THE MAIN EVENT IN SUPPORT OF THE VLADECK HOME FUND DRIVE WILL BE THE SECOND ANNUAL SPRING DANCE, TO BE HELD AT THE LOS ANGELES BREAKFAST CLUB ON MARCH 15, 1947. MANY OTHER CITY-WIDE AND BRANCH AFFAIRS ARE BEING PLANNED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THIS WORTHY CAUSE.

THE VLADECK HOME COMBINES ALL THE FEATURES OF A SANATORIUM, HOME AND SCHOOL FOR THE HOMELESS JEWISH WAIFS WHO SURVIVED THE HITLER HOLOCAUST. AT PRESENT, BETWEEN 100 AND 125 TUBERCULAR AND UNDERNOURISHED CHILDREN ARE BEING CARED FOR BY A SPECIALIZED STAFF OF DOCTORS AND NURSES. WHAT FORMERLY WAS AN OLD CHATEAU AT BRUNOY (S ET 0) FRANCE, 20 MILES FROM PARIS, IS NOW A PLACE WHERE NOT ONLY THE PHYSICAL NEEDS OF THESE CHILDREN ARE CARED FOR, BUT WHERE THEY ARE TAUGHT A WAY OF LIFE THAT WILL HELP THEM REGAIN THEIR FAITH IN HUMAN NATURE AND ENABLE THEM TO FACE THE FUTURE WITHOUT FEAR.

THE HOME IS NAMED FOR THE LATE B. CHARNEY VLADECK, FOUNDER OF THE JEWISH LABOR COMMITTEE AND ONE-TIME MAJORITY LEADER OF THE NEW YORK CITY COUNCIL, WHOSE WHOLE LIFE WAS DEVOTED TO HUMANITARIAN, JEWISH AND LABOR CAUSES. THE HOME WAS ESTABLISHED UNDER THE JOINT RESPONBIBILITY OF THE WORKMEN'S CIRCLE OF AMERICA AND OF FRANCE, AND THE JEWISH LABOR COMMITTEE. UNDER THESE AUSPICES OVER 3,000 ORPHANED CHILDREN AND WAR VICTIMS ARE BEING CARED FOR IN THE LE MAN AND THE NAHUM A. RONSON HOMES, THE PERETZ SCHOOL IN BRUSSELS, AND OTHER SCHOOL-HOMES, REST CENTERS AND SANATORIA.

IT IS PLANNED TO EXPAND THE FACILITIES OF THE VLADECK HOME TO ACCOMMODATE UP TO 300 CHILDREN IN THE NEAR FUTURE. \$100,000 WILL GO FAR TOWARDS THE REAL-IZATION OF THIS GOAL. GENEROUS AID THROUGH THE MEDIUM OF THE WORKMEN'S CIRCLE BY ALL CONCERNED PERSONS WILL INSURE A HAPPIER FUTURE FOR THESE HELPLESS VICTIMS OF THE WAR.

EDUCATE FOR TOLERANCE

OUR ANTI-INTOLERANCE CAMPAIGN HAS MADE SOME REAL HEADWAY IN THE PAST TWO MONTHS, IN THE LOS ANGELES RANKS OF THE AMERICAN FEDERATION OF LABOR. THE AFL COMMITTEE TO COMBAT INTOLERANCE HAS WON AMAZING PRESTIGE, AND REAL RESPLCT BECAUSE OF THE QUIET AND BASIC WAY IN WHICH IT IS TACKLING THE ISSUES OF DISCRIMINATION AND RACE PREJUDICE.

IN THE FIGHT TO EMACT A FAIR EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES BILL IN THIS STATE,
THE AFL COMMITTEE PLAYED A REAL ROLE
ON BEHALF OF THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA
AFL. ALTHOUGH FEPC WAS BEATEN AT THE
POLLS, WE WERE INSTRUMENTAL IN MOBIL—
12ING INTELLIGENT LABOR ACTION FOR
THE PRINCIPLES OF FAIR EMPLOYMENT AND
ARE PLANNING RENEWED PRESSURE FOR A
STATE AND NATIONAL FEPC LAW.

IN THE PAST TWO MONTHS, SOME DOZEN UNIONS, AND THOUSANDS OF INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS OF THE LOCALS, HAVE HEARD AND SEEN OUR FILM SHOWS, TALKS AND LITERA-



RACE AND RELIGIOUS HATE HURTS....YOU! TURE ON RACE RELATIONS. SOME TWO DOZEN OTHERS ARE BOOKED FOR PROGRAMS WITHIN THE NEXT FEW WEEKS. INCREASINGLY, UNIONS ARE TURNING TO US, AND NOWHERE YET HAVE WE MET A NEGATIVE RESPONSE. WITHIN A TWO MONTH PERIOD, THE LOCAL AFL LEADERSHIP HAS BECOME CONVINCED THAT AN AFL DRIVE ON INTOL-ERANCE IS BASIC TRADE UNIONISM, AND IS ALSO AN EFFECTIVE PUBLIC RELATIONS AND ORGANIZING TECHNIQUE.

WHILE TRADE UNION GROUPS HAVE BEEN OUR BASIC AREA OF OPERATION, OTHERS TOO HAVE PARTICIPATED IN OUR WORK. THEY INCLUDE, AMONG MANY, B'NAI B'RITH, HILLEL COUNCIL, WORKMEN'S CIRCLE, ALL NATIONS FOUNDATION, POMONA OPEN FORUM, AND RELIGION AND LABOR COUNCIL AUDIENCES.

LEST ONE BECOME COMPLACENT AND THINK THAT THE FIGHT AGAINST INTOLERANCE IS GOING WELL, LET ME SAY THAT THE THREAT OF BIGOTRY, AND DISCRIMINATION IN CALIFORNIA, AND NATIONALLY, IS INCREASING, NOT DECREASING. AND OUR PROGRAMS REACH ALL TOO FEW GROUPS BECAUSE OF LIMITED RESOURCES AND LACK OF PERSONNEL. THE AMERICAN PEOPLE'S CONSCIENCE MAS RESPONDED TIME AND AGAIN TO APPEALS FOR FOOD TO RELIEVE HUNGER IN EUROPE, BUT AREAS OF HUNGER STILL PERSIST.

AN ADDITIONAL ORGANIZATION HAS NOW ARRIVED UPON THE SCENE -THE COOPERATIVE FOR AMERICAN REMITTANCES TO EUROPE OR CARE FOR SMORT. THIS ORGANIZATION EMPLOYS A SWIFT, NOVEL METHOD BY WHICH PEOPLE IN THIS COUNTRY CAN ARRANGE FOR THE DELIVERY OF FOOD TO INDIVIDUALS OR FAMILIES IN II EUROPEAN COUNTRIES.

THE FOOD IS ALREADY IN EUROPE, ORIGINALLY INTENDED FOR OUR INVASION SOLDIERS WHO WERE HAPPILY SPARED ITS NEED, MADE AVAILABLE FOR EUROPEAN DISTRIBUTION BY THE WAR ASSETS ADMINISTRATION.

A \$10 ORDER WILL SEND A 40-POUND PACKAGE, INCLUDING SUCH FOODS AS HAM, BACON, CORN, PRESERVED BUTTER, COFFEE, CHOCOLATE, AND MARMALADE, PLUS CIGARETTES, TO ANY INDIVIDUAL OF YOUR CHOICE, WITH DELIVERY GUARANTEED BY CARE INSIDE OF FOUR MONTHS. THE PACKAGE IS TAX-FREE, DUTY-FREE, ENTAILS NO SACRIFICE OF ORDINARY RATIONS, CONTAINS 40,000 CALORIES, AND MAY MAKE THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN MALNUTRITION - AND HEALTH.

"HAD PROUGH"

WITH THE USE OF A SIMPLE SLOBAN WHICH SEEMED TO CHANNEL THE DISCONTENT OF THE NATION INTO A NUTSHELL, THE REPUBLICAN PARTY SWEPT ITSELF INTO POWER. THE FAMOUS NEW DEAL, WHICH HAD PREVIOUSLY MINDED ITS P'S AND Q'S WITHOUT RECEIVING COMPLAINTS, NOW FOUND ITSELF FLOUNDERING IN ITS OWN ALPHABET SOUP. THOSE OF US WHO REMEMBER THE ILL-FATED HOOVER REGIME, AND WHO HAVE THOUGHT-FULLY CONSIDERED THE SPARSE REPUBLICAN PROGRAM HAVE GOOD CAUSE TO DISBELIEVE THAT THE "CORNER OF PROSPERITY" WILL TURN UP NOW ANY MORE THAN BEFORE. INSTEAD, WE HAVE AN IDEA THAT INSTEAD OF THE O.P.A., THE REPUBLICANS WILL ATTEMPT TO REASSURE AND DULL THE MINDS OF THE PUBLIC WITH THEIR "OPA-JATES."

TO BE SURE THE PEOPLE HAVE "HAD ENOUGH." BUT IS IT THE DEMOCRATS THEY HAVE HAD ENOUGH OF - OR ARE THEY "TIRED OF IT ALL" -- THE ENTIRE SYSTEM OF ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL INSECURITY WHICH PERMITS WAGES WHICH NEVER QUITE CATCH UP WITH SOARING PRICES - A SCARCITY OF THE ESSENTIALS OF LIVING, CONTINUING RACIAL PREJUDICES, AND A WORLD DANGEROUSLY UNSTEADY AND UNBALANCED AFTER ITS EXPLOSIVE WAR EXPERIENCES, LACKING RESPONSIBLE LEADERSHIP TO SET IT SQUARELY UPON ITS AXIS.

TO OUR WAY OF THINKING - THIS RECENT VOTE CAN BE JUDGED AS A PROTEST VOTE AGAINST THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY'S FAILURE TO PRODUCE ORDER OUT OF CHAOS, CONSEQUENTLY ALLOWING THE PRIMARY COMPETING POLITICAL PARTY TO EMERGE VICTORIOUS
IN THE ELECTION - BUT IN ADDITION, THIS FACT MUST BE SERIOUSLY CONSIDERED.
WHAT WOULD THE RESULT HAVE BEEN IF THERE HAD EXISTED A THIRD PARTY, COMPOSED
- NOT OF ECONOMIC ROYALISTS - BUT OF HUNDREDS OF THOUSANDS OF TRADE UNION MEMBERS, LIBERALS, FARMERS, ETC. - STANDING FOR A DYNAMIC PROGRAM OF PLANNED PRODUCTION FOR USE AND NOT FOR PROFIT, FOR ECONOMIC, POLITICAL AND SOCIAL SECURITY AND FOR A LASTING PEACE.

WE FIRMLY BELIEVE THAT HAD SUCH A PARTY OF PROGRAM AND ACTION BEEN ON THE SCENE, THE ELECTION RESULTS WOULD HAVE SHOWN THAT ACTUALLY THE AMERICAN PEOPLE HAVE "HAD ENOUGH" OF BOTH TWEEDLE-DEE AND TWEEDLE-DUM - AND THIS NEW PARTY WITH ITS VISION, COURAGE AND PROGRAM OF PROGRESSIVE ACTION WAS WHAT THEY WERE DESPERATELY IN NEED OF, AND FOR WHICH THEY WOULD HAVE VOTED.

CERTAINLY THE ELECTION MUST GIVE US ADDED INCENTIVE AND DETERMINATION TO BUILD SUCH A NEW PARTY - STARTING NOW.
