STORYBOARDING: MAPPING OUT YOUR PROJECT

Storyboarding is an activity which helps you physically map out all of the visual, audio, and special effects elements and their relationship with each other inside your digital story . The way storyboards work is you write the specific line of your script in the space provided underneath each of the little t.v. boxes.
