A well selected guide of some 600 works in Chinese classified by form into bibliographies, encyclopedias, dictionaries, geographical works, biographical works, tables, yearbooks, and sinological indexes. Annotations are detailed, descriptive, and sometimes critical. Introduction precedes each division and subdivision. Combined author/title index and glossary. A standard work for students in sinology.
- 2 GARDE, P. K. Directory of reference works published in Asia. Paris, United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization, 1956. 139p.
Section on China lists works published before 1949, mostly in Chinese, some in English. Also includes section on Taiwan after 1949.
- 3 TSIEN TSUEN-HSUIN. A guide to reference and source materials for Chinese studies (preliminary draft). Chicago, Graduate Library School, University of Chicago, 1970. 114p.; supplement, 1977. 28p. Mimeographed ed.
A partially annotated list of 1,200 entries, divided into 17 sections by types of materials and subjects; includes reference tools, major sources, and standard monographs in Chinese, Japanese, and Western languages. Supplement for 1971-77 adds 280 titles.
