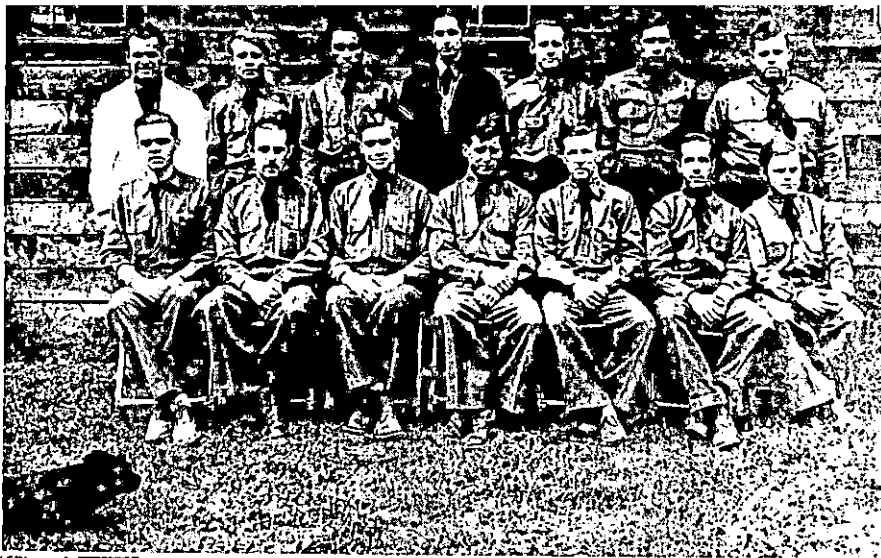

History . . .

Company 3280, CCC, was organized at Fort Dix, New Jersey, on April 4, 1939. An advanced cadre was furnished by the Schenectady District, New York. The Company left Fort Dix for the West on April 10th, arriving at Belton, Montana, on April 15th, 1939.

All work projects of this Company have been in Glacier National Park, Montana. Chief work con-

sists of Fire Fighting, Fire Hazard Reduction, and Park Maintenance. The Company was called out on fire fighting duty several times during the summer of 1939.
