

What: Preventing pollution problems from lawn and garden fertilizers
In an effort to reduce phosphorus runoff to surface waters, the Minnesota state legislature passed laws in 2002 and 2004 that restrict phosphorus fertilizer use on lawns. New guidelines for compliance with these laws are detailed here.
