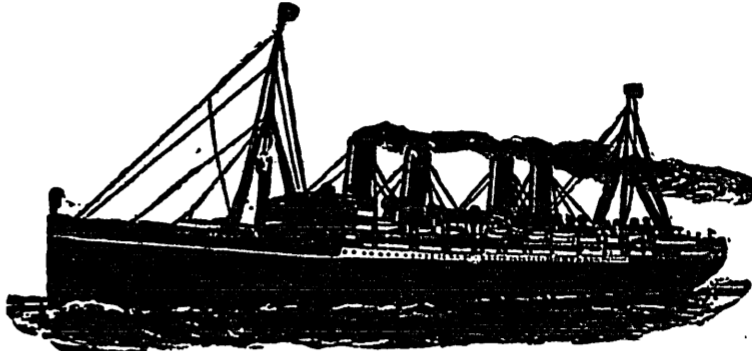
Pharisee, can't you see Ethiopia's rising bright? Pharisee, can't you see You must follow their star for the light?
