History of Ski Sport

Organized skiing had its inception right here in Red Wing in the year 1883 when a group of local residents, largely those of Norwegian birth, evolved the plan of bringing to this country four of their countrymen who had won King's honors for their skiing exploits in Norway.

From that beginning the ski sport rapidly expanded to other communities, particularly to the Scandinavian settlements of Minnesota, Wisconsin and Illinois. Such a thrilling and invigorating sport was bound to gain popularity and now there are over 500 organized ski clubs in the United States.

Whereas, it was considered marvelous to make jumps of 75 feet in the olden days, it is not infrequent now for many of the skilled riders to leap through space 200 to 250 feet—the longest recorded jump being 267 feet.

When you spectators view these daredevils on this hill today appreciate the fact that they are traveling at the speed of 80 to 100 miles per hour—always dependent upon their own resources.

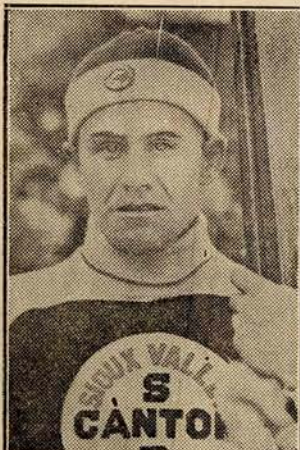

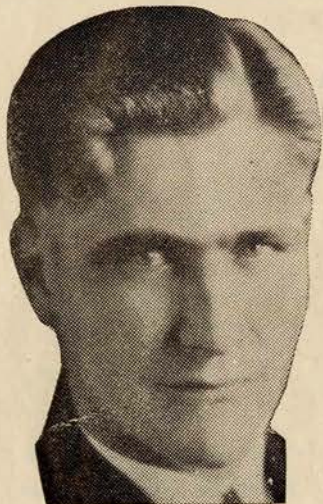

AURORA SKI CLUB

● The Aurora Ski Club of Red Wing, Minnesota, is the oldest organized ski club in America. In 1883 a quartet of Norwegian skiers—Mikel and Torjus Hemmesvedt, Paul Henningstad and Dr. Bengdt Hjermstad—were prevailed upon to come to America and settle in Red Wing. The Hemmesvedt brothers were noteworthy skiers in Norway. Torjus had been decorated by the king while the other three were also known as champions in their native land. Upon their arrival here the first ski club was formed. Since then the Aurora club has produced many wonderful skiers who gained national renown. Foremost among these are Francis Kempe, national champion in 1911, Carl Ek, oldest active class A rider; and the late Halvor Bjorngaard, conceded to be the most graceful rider ever to strap on a pair of boards.
