SOVIET, EAST EUROPEAN & SLAVONIC STUDIES IN BRITAIN 1972

INTRODUCTION

This bibliography aims to include all books, periodical and newspaper articles, reviews and other items of relevance to the study of the Soviet Union and Eastern Europe published in English in Great Britain in 1972. The first such bibliography, covering 1971, appeared with ABSEES, Vol. III, No. 1, July 1972.

Books and certain periodical articles which were missing from the 1971 bibliography have been included; 1971 books have been distinguished from their 1972 colleagues by including the date 1971 in the entry. American and other foreign books issued in Great Britain are in the bibliography; also a suggestion that the contents of symposia be indexed has been adopted. All reviews of 1971 and 1972 books, including some of 1972 books appearing in sources early in 1973, plus major reviews of older books, are listed. Items published abroad by British scholars (in English) have been included where notified. There is a short Appendix of late items.

The classification is a mixture of that used for ABSEES and of categories suggested by the material itself. There are three sections: Soviet Union and Eastern Europe which contains items relevant to the whole area covered by the bibliography; Soviet Union, the largest section; and Eastern Europe, which is headed by a general section and is then split into the various East European countries. To give some guidance: most past events are classified under History, current or recent events under Politics and Government and Foreign Relations; all bibliographical items appear under Bibliography and Libraries rather than under any specific subject concerned; censorship is under Arts and Culture, archaeology and numismatics under History, demography and peasant conditions under Social Data and Problems, environmental matters under Geography, housing under Economic Conditions and Economic History but architecture under Arts and Culture. Division into subheadings has been eschewed in some smaller East European country sections where entries have been arranged in alphabetical order. Throughout the Bibliography reviews are classified at the end of sections; their numbers are preceded by the letter R.

The form of reference used for periodicals is that of Roman numerals for volume numbers and Arabic numerals for numbers within volume; thus XXIII, 1/72. Where there is no numbering within the volume, the month is given; thus XVII, Feb/72. The index contains all proper names given in the entries.

Acknowledgements are due to the British National Bibliography, the British Education, Humanities and Technical Indexes, to Mrs. B. Richter, Information Officer at CREES, Birmingham, for the use of her newspaper file, to the staff of the Central Asian Research Centre, to Mrs. L. Hnik for help in the final putting-together, to C.M.A. McCauley, Esq., for checking sections at the proof stage, to those who offered comments on the 1971 bibliography and finally to those who sent information about their publications to ABSEES. The compilers would greatly appreciate continued notification of publications, either through the ABSEES Information Bulletins or directly.
