## Community Exhibitions:

"The Community Archive and Collection Corridors in the Los Angeles Region exhibition series placed [sic] a spotlight on the identification and recovery of less visible archives and collections that contribute to our understanding of Los Angeles past and present."

Items from community archives and collections residing in corridors in the Los Angeles region and listed in the L.A. as Subject directory were displayed at two community-based art galleries:

## Social and Public Art Resource Center (SPARC) Gallery Illuminating Visual Culture, Artifacts and Documents: The Harbor and Coastal Cities Corridor

• Harbor and Coastal Cities Corridor encompassing costal cities from the Ventura County line to the Orange County line

## Watts Labor Community Action Committee (WLCAC) Gallery Expressions in the Gallery: Less Visible Material Culture in the Central City Corridor

• Central City Corridor, bounded by L.A. Civic Center to the north, East Los Angeles to the east, the West Los Angeles line to the west, and Watts to the south.
