PREFACE

This little book contains English—Yoruba Vocabulary on different Subjects which will be useful to those learning meaning of words commonly used in every day life.

Students will commit the vocabulary to memory. Provision is made at the latter part of the book on the line of Conjugation of verbs as no correct sentences could be formed without the knowledge of Conjugation.

Teachers could supply other words under each Section which are not included in the list.

On the point of Grammar children could be drilled under each Section to supply the plural numbers and genders of nouns which are listed in the book.

As regards verbs which are listed, different sentences could be formed in different tenses, and in the advanced classes, principal parts of verbs could be asked from the list of verbs. Comparison of adjectives could be had from the list of Adjectives supplied in the book.

Only verbs in the Active Voice are treated in the conjugation of verbs, but the Teachers could make the classes learn those of the Passive Voice from any English Grammar text book.

It is anticipated that this book will supply the need that is felt on the line of acquiring a wealth of English—Yoruba Vocabulary.
